Want to spend two weeks at Camp?

Are you going into 6th-9th grade this fall?

Looking for something fun to do to end your summer right
or just get away for a couple weeks?

This is your chance!

Who: **Fun, energetic,** and **enthusiastic** girls and guys, entering grades 6-9 in the fall. Join us for this two-week overnight camp (Aug. 9-22) to serve with the Sealth Conservation Construction Corps, designed to get teens in touch with their community and the environment. Limited to 16 participants. *Space is filled on a first come, first served basis.*

What: Attend this special session at Camp Sealth on Vashon Island, designed especially for teens. Youth Volunteers will help with the maintenance and improvements of camp facilities and surrounding greenscape. They will gain leadership skills, team work, construction knowledge, skills in proper building materials and tool use, native plant identification and planting, and also get to enjoy some traditional camp activities. Youth Volunteers will **work hard**, but also **play hard!**

Why: This once-in-a-lifetime opportunity of volunteer environmental restoration, awareness, and maintenance projects. Youth Volunteers who serve 100 hours will **qualify for a \$500 education award***, to be used towards post secondary education. Attending the full two-week session will satisfy the **required 100 hours** of environmental community service to receive their award.

Program Fee: \$22/day per participant! ****75% discount from regular Camp Sealth tuition**** for two weeks, includes: transportation, all meals, lodging, and around the clock supervision. Payment plans available.

*Education awards are administered through The Corporation for National and Community Service, not Camp Fire USA or Youth Volunteer Corps of America, and cannot be collected until the youth turns 18. Must be U.S. Citizen.
