*Location: Waterfront, past Village cabins. Children under age 5 must be able to fit into a life jacket, and be one-on-one with a parent. All children and adults must wear a life jacket. Activity is dependent on weather/water conditions.*

**Marine Aquariums** 10 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

*Location: Large boat dock by waterfront. All ages welcome.*
