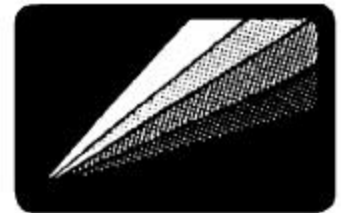

Come to *Trailsfest 2005!*

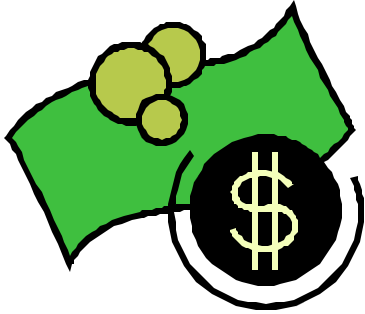

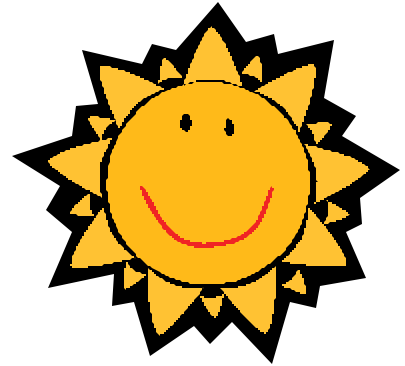
