COST: \$8 per table. Payment due with registration.

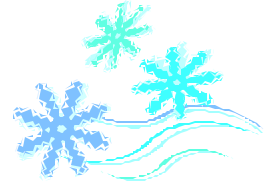
THINGS TO REMEMBER:

1. **YOUR GROUP'S MEMBERSHIP MUST BE CURRENT TO PARTICIPATE.**
2. Your group **must** have participated in the 2004 Magazine and Music Fundraiser and have plans to participate in the 2005 Candy Fundraiser.
3. At least two adults must accompany each group. You are responsible for the actions of your youth.
4. Sale price of items will be \$7.50 or less. Lower priced items, \$2 or less, will be your biggest sellers. Prices should be clearly marked. All money must go to your group treasury or be donated to charity.
5. There are a limited number of electrical outlets. They are available first come, first served. No kitchen facilities are available.
6. Items must be handmade. This is a children's bazaar, with children buying items made by other children.
7. **There will be NO RAFFLES of any kind.**
8. Baked goods must be covered at all times. Food sold individually must be wrapped separately or handled with tongs or waxed paper.
9. Major food items will not be duplicated; first registered will have priority. One adult must have a food handler permit from the County Health Department if you are selling food that is not wrapped.

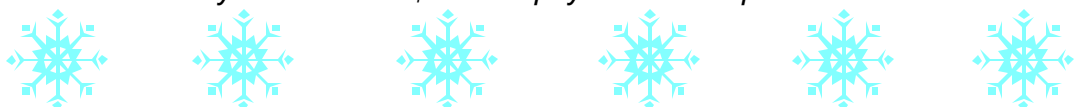

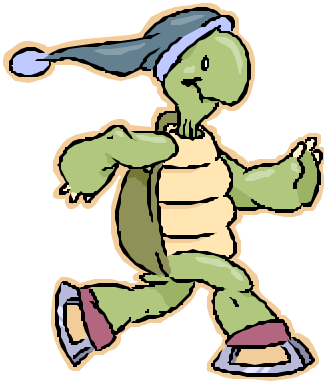

Winter Field Trips

Ice Skating – take your group to a local rink for an afternoon or evening of slippery fun. Several ice skating rinks are in the south end including Castle Ice Arena at 12620 164th Ave SE in Renton, the Kent Valley Ice Center at 6015 S. 240th St. and Sprinkers at 14824 Centre St. S Suite 107 in Tacoma.

Castle Ice offers “Cheap Skate” night on Tuesdays from 6:30 - 8:15 (\$3.25), Teen Night on Fridays from 7:30 - 10:15, which includes a DJ, colored lights and disco ball, and Family Skate Nights on Fridays from 7 - 10 p.m. Weekday rates are \$6.50 per session and \$2.50 for skate rental. Weekends the cost is \$7.50. Group rates are available for groups of 50+. For more information call 425 254 8750 or visit their website at www.castleice.com/arena.html.

The Kent Valley Ice Center offers “Cheap Skate” on Wednesday nights from 7 - 8 p.m. (\$5) and a Friday Night Skate with black lights and a DJ from 7:30 - 10:30 p.m. General admission is \$7.25 for adults and \$6.25 for youth 4 - 12. Skate rental is \$2.75. Group rates for 8 - 24 people are \$.50 off general admission rates and for 25 - 50 people, \$1 off general admission. The Kent Valley Ice Center also has Batting Cages. 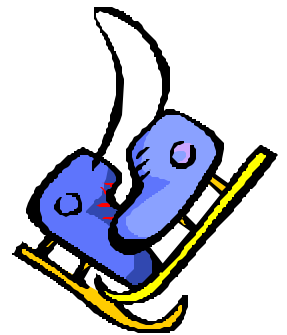
Sprinkler Recreation Center and Ice Arena is located in Tacoma and offers “Cheap Skate” for \$4 including skates on Sundays from 7 - 8:45 p.m. and Wednesdays from 6:30 - 8:15 p.m. General admission is \$5 for adults, \$4 for youth 6 - 17 and skate rental for \$2. Holiday parades – There are several towns in the South Branch that hold holiday parades in early December. Take your group either to participate in the parade or just to watch it.

Kent’s Winterfest Parade is held the first Saturday in December - this year December 4th. This is a “lighted” parade and encourages incorporating Christmas lights in your entry. The parade starts at 4:30 p.m., (line up begins at 3 p.m.), and ends with the annual tree lighting.

Enumclaw also has a yearly holiday parade and tree lighting ceremony. This year’s parade is December 4th at 6 p.m. on Cole Street.

Theater – Local theater productions are also a fun way to do something together as a group. Green River Community College’s Heavier Than Air Family Theatre is presenting “Babes in Toyland” December 17 - 21st.
