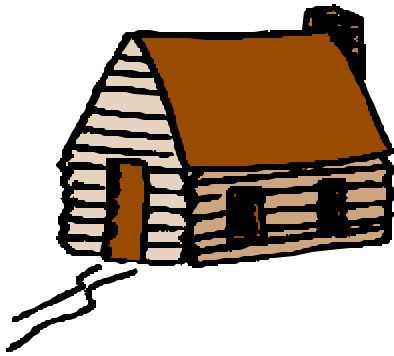
An age appropriate program will be presented by a museum educator. Take Highway 3 to the Keyport exit North of Silverdale. Follow the signs to the museum.

Saturday night dinner and Sunday morning breakfast will be provided with a little set-up and clean-up help from you.

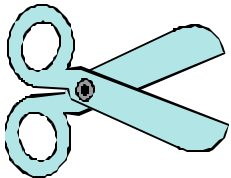
