Regarding recent blog posts regarding the former Camp Fire Property located in Maple Leaf at 8511 15th NE in Seattle – Camp Fire Central Puget Sound Council would like to respond as follows:

- Camp Fire supports the City's acquisition of a conservation easement over a portion of Camp Fire's former property
- The City of Seattle has agreed to pay the MMSC School \$300,000 for the conservation easement
- The City's appraisal did find that the property will be worth over \$600,000 less after the City buys the conservation easement. That means that if the school does not pay Camp Fire the remaining amount we are owed and Camp Fire has to foreclose, there will be \$600,000 less in proceeds to pay other parties.
- Camp Fire Central Puget Sound Council is a 100 year old national not for profit organization serving over 12,000 youth and families in the Puget Sound area.
